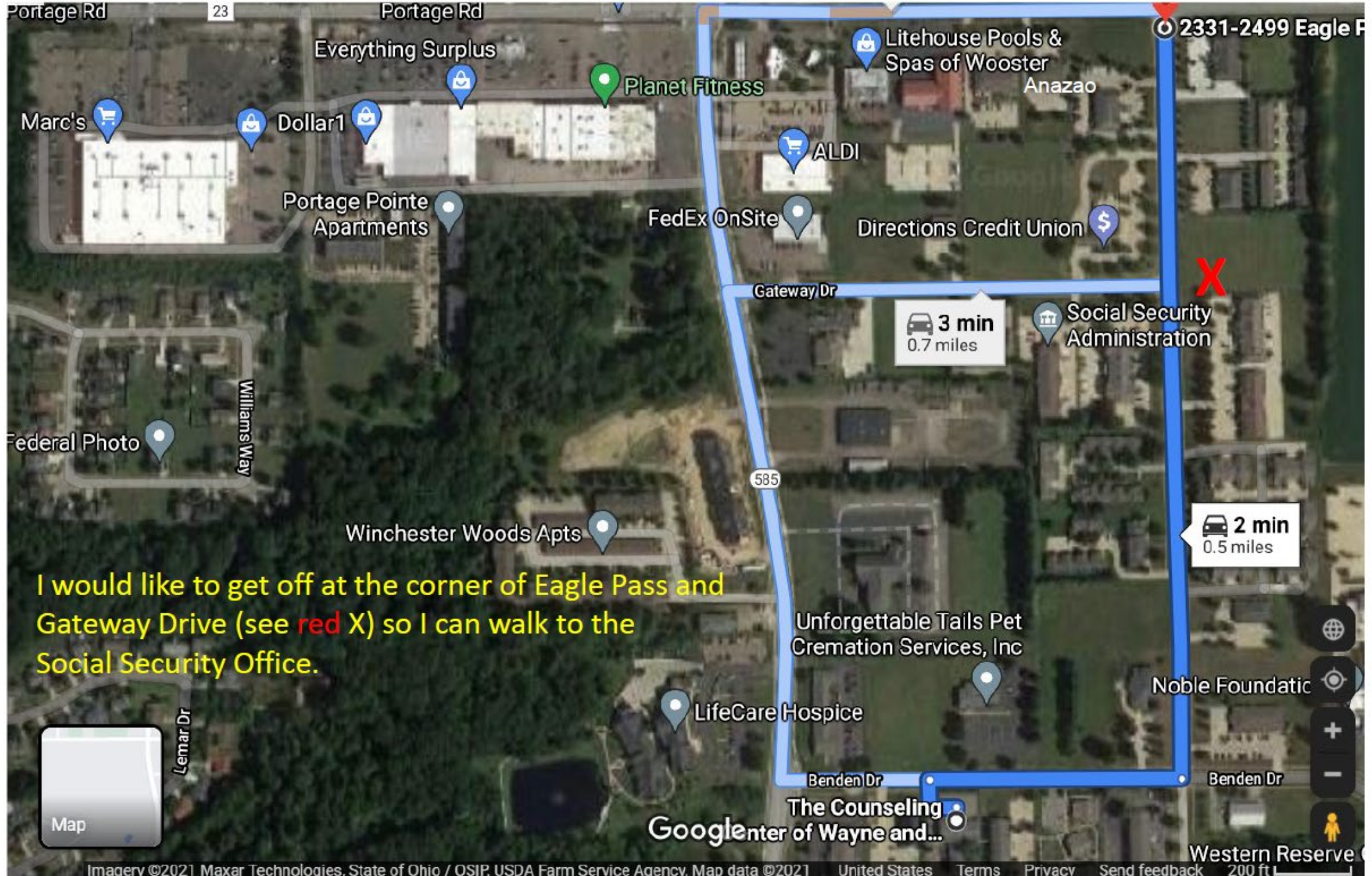


Obtaining a Social Security card

- Social Security Administration, 2345 Gateway Dr # B, Wooster, OH 44691, Open Monday-Friday 9 am – 4 pm. <http://saa.gov> telephone (1) 877-319-0729

Go to their website and find out which documents you need. Call the phone number above and make an appointment. If you are taking the Wooster Transit blue line bus, it passes by The Social Security office at 26 minutes after each hour, if it is on time. Thus you could explain you are arriving by bus and request an appointment for 30 minutes after the hour, or 45 minutes after the hour, in case the bus is running late.

- You can board Wooster Transit buses only at stops designated with a Wooster Transit sign. **But you can** ask your driver to let you get off at any point along the route that the bus driver considers safe. The Social Security Office is between stops number 14 and 15 on the route, shown on the map as The Counseling Center of Wayne and as the red dot at the top right of the map.
- So I suggest you print out the Google map image below of that neighborhood and give it to the driver when you board the bus. By getting off at the corner of Eagle Pass and Gateway Drive (see red X) you can walk to the Social Security Office in just one minute.
- In waiting for the next bus after your appointment, if you want to do some shopping, there is an Aldi supermarket nearby. Or you could spend about 12 minutes walking the 1 km to Marc's supermarket, where there is a Wooster Transit stop at 30 minutes past each hour.
- Note that the blue line of Wooster Transit <https://woostertransit.com/> (the only line on which our campus, the Social Security office and Marc's supermarket have a stop) run only until 5 pm until further notice due to a nationwide driver shortage. So if you do not get on the bus at a stop nearby at 3:25-3:30 (see timetable excerpt below), you will not be on that same last bus when it arrives on our campus at 4:12 and 4:13 pm.



I would like to get off at the corner of Eagle Pass and Gateway Drive (see red X) so I can walk to the Social Security Office.

Park National Bank is the only building you must pass on your left side on Gateway Drive before walking up the driveway of the Social Security Administration's parking lot.
